Online, there is a college student who not only vlogs her daily school routines at Melbourne University but also makes many videos on studying tips, making things more realistic in case plan changes occur or if exams were to come soon. I used to be a very unproductive student in eighth grade and got very low grades as a result because I always complained about factors I couldn't control, but when she gave tips on how to avoid procrastination and other and studying issues while still keeping responsible for how we spent our time, I was able to have a more focused workflow during my study sessions. I didn't just learn how to

write my answers to get good grades, but I also understood the material and learned to enjoy the learning process. Furthermore, her vlogs only boosted my motivation with the bright mood yet productive ambiance.

5) The fears and challenges that you need to overcome.

One fear that I feel is holding me back is stage fright. After I went back to school post-COVID, I found myself struggling to give proper speeches due to the worry of saying the wrong thing. This affected my ability to communicate my points clearly. Many said that they couldn't hear what I said. However, since then, I've been improving my speech by giving a more confident voice and getting more comfortable with speaking in front of an audience by participating in more presentations. This has certainly improved my public speaking. I have received feedback that not only I am heard at the back of the room but that my voice shows confidence.
