Questionnaire for the Applicant

1) How would you introduce yourself? (State your aims, expectations from life, hobbies, likes and dislikes, any philosophy you believe in)

I am Shiven and besides the outdoor and sports, I have recently started to develop interest in economics and market. I aspire to be a professional football player competing in big league. I know it is quite demanding, and therefore the need to develop mental and physical strength. My mantra, life will not be easy, therefore prepare yourself to lead a happy one.

2) Why did you choose to do an IBDP?

I am an IB student since MYP2. The IB curriculum has been offering me real world learning that intends to prepare me for the future.
